### Project Updates

#### Branding + Project Identity

The project team unveiled the proposed branding and asked Committee members for feedback. The consultants walked Committee members through the process, vision board, and questionnaire which inspired the proposed design. The proposed branding includes a logo, monogram, and font intended to capture the spirit of both hamlets. The Hamlet Committee selected the name and subtitle of the project to be, *"The Northern Hamlet Master Plan: Bridging Our Future Together"*.

### Discussion

What are the challenges and opportunities facing our hamlets?

Utilizing an interactive map, Committee members were tasked with using their experiences and knowledge of place to start to identify key assets, and potential hamlet boundaries. Some visual "ques" that provide a sense of arrival were mapped and noted:

- Intersection of Willow Glen as the point south
- Willow Glen (diner, bar)
- Seneca Turnpike
  - At Willow Glen, corner of Jordan Street
  - Crossroads, 4-way stop
- Mill Road at Old Seneca (southern entrance of the Charlie Major Nature Trail)
- Coming from the north; Empire Cheese as visual que
- Mottville from Auburn – dense housing; County line
