Assets and Study Area Boundary

The project team met for a working meeting to identify challenges, opportunities, and future development considerations. The project team developed a draft study area boundary based on existing conditions, topography, environmental factors, and perception of the community.

Key takeaways from the discussion include:

Challenges and Opportunities

- + Affordable housing
- + Opportunities for more connecting trails throughout
- + Redevelop vacant properties (the Block + Dimarco Factory)
 - o Industrial buildings that can be reused
- + Walkability/bikeability
- + Lack of signage (wayfinding) for both vehicles and pedestrians
- + Lack of traffic calming measures
- + Trails not welcome to bikers (kids use, cyclists don't)
- + Jordan Rd. / 22 is dangerous (design speed)
- + No sewer (nor is expansion likely)
- + Brownfield sites
