Site Specific

- Safe crossing at Seneca Tpke and Mill Rd intersection
- Include more of Crow Hill in the boundary there are small residential properties to capture (at Crow Hill Rd intersection with boundary)
- Save the bridge (Crow Hill Rd bridge)
- Reduce dangerous street parking and enforce existing no parking zones (Jordan and Railroad intersection in Mottville)
- Sidewalks along Jordan Rd. to make walking safer. Sidewalks to nature trail
- The hamlet of Mottville stops here! (adjacent to Hillrom just over Mottville Rd)
- Bike lane on Jordan Rd (Skaneateles Falls specifically)
- Develop this factory into something worthwhile (abandoned looking site on Jordan Road right next to "Skaneateles Falls" location title on map)
