



Which of the following businesses do we need more of, and where? Check the appropriate columns to indicate your preferences.




Most popular responses for Mottville and Skaneateles Falls included:




COMMUNITY OPPORTUNITIES

hamlets




• **61.4%** of survey participants indicated that they were INTERESTED or VERY INTERESTED in trail connectivity from Mottville and Skaneateles Falls to the village




Where would you like to see residential growth in Mottville and Skaneateles Falls? Check any that apply.

- Fear of "outsiders"


Transformational projects:

- Replacement of pipes



Population in the Study Area




Population in the Town of Skaneateles




HOUSEHOLD COMPOSITION
