Clift Park Waterfront Rules

- **Absolutely** no swimming when Lifeguards are **NOT** on duty.
- Always obey Lifeguards, or you will be asked to leave.
- Children under the age of 7 must be accompanied by an adult when in or around the water and the adult must be within arm's reach.
- Non-Coast Guard approved flotation devices will **NOT** be allowed.
- Properly sized US Coast Guard approved lifejackets are permitted within shallow and 1st raft buoy lines.
- Recreational Flotation devices are not allowed in swimming area (noodles, tubes, etc.)
- Stay within the buoy lines.
- No one is allowed to enter swimming area to open water swim.
- Swim tests are required in order to swim past the "shallow" swimming areas.
- Non-swimmers are **NOT** allowed on second raft (1st raft allowed with lifejacket and within arm's reach of a supervising adult)
- Proper swim attire only! No cutoff jeans, shorts or street clothing allowed.
- No running or horseplay allowed on rafts or in the water.
- Diving and flipping off rafts is prohibited
- Do not swim under rafts or lifeguard chairs.
- No eating, drinking, or SMOKING in the swimming area.
- No glass is allowed in the beach area.
- No pets in swim area
- No alcoholic beverages permitted in the swimming area.
- Patrons are not allowed to use whistles near the beach area.
- Boating, Water-skiing, Tubing or Boarding is prohibited in swimming areas and within buoy lines.
