Rules & Regulations of the Transfer Station

<u>Per Section 118-9</u> of the Town Refuse Law, <u>permits</u> are required to enter and all residents are required to recycle.

Permits are available at the Town Hall, 24 Jordan Street, or at the Transfer Station for a fee of **\$20.00 per Household**.

<u>Per Section 118-5</u> All loads must be covered.

<u>Per Section 118-6</u> Only Refuse that has originated from the Town of Skaneateles will be accepted.

<u>Per section</u> 118-9 Commercial loads and Haulers require a Commercial Permit available at the Town Hall.

WARNING: <u>Per Section 118-11</u> Depositing refuse which has not originated in the Town of Skaneateles is punishable by a \$250.00 fine and or 15 days imprisonment.

All vehicles entering the Transfer Station are required to display a Valid Transfer Station Permit.

Any person or company who violates any provision in the rules and regulations could be prohibited from future use of the Transfer Station and may be subject to suspension or revocation of their Transfer Station Permit.

* Tree Haulers will be responsible for each home owner completing a form stating the Town Address that the trees are coming from, the type of tree and how many. These forms must be completed and given to an employee of The Town of Skaneateles Transfer Station before depositing trees. The forms are available at the Transfer Station and the Skaneateles Town Hall.

- NO HARDFILL
- NO COMPACTED LOADS
- NO WOOD
- NO C&D (CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL)
- NO PAINT

Garbage:

Place in compactor. Clear or White bags only.

Deposit in designated bins:

- -Fluorescent light bulbs
- -Car Batteries
- -Used Motor oil

Recyclables: Single Stream RecyclingNo Need To Separate

DEPOSIT IN THE WHITE BUILDING

Paper Products:

Newspaper, cardboard boxes (broken down), magazines, catalogues, junk mail, office paper, phone books, non-corrugated cardboard, thin-paper, cardboard such as cereal boxes, Kleenex boxes, pasta, boxes, pizza boxes, shoe boxes, food boxes, beer boxes, soda boxes, etc.

Containers:

- -Glass (food or drink)
- -Tin Cans
- -Plastic Containers # 1, 2 and 5 Examples: laundry detergent, shampoo, milk, and soda bottles.
- -Gable top milk and juice containers.

All of the recyclables have to be emptied from the trash bag that they are in and the bag needs to be thrown in the trash. Bags are <u>NOT</u> recyclable.

See your local grocery stores for recycling your shopping bags.

Swap Shop:

Working, reusable items only.

Metal Pile Items:

- -Washer/ Dryer/ Stove
- -Lawn mowers, Bikes
- -Lawn Chairs, Metal Pipes
- -Gutters, Sheet Metal
- -Hot Water Heaters
- -Small/Large Kitchen Appliances
- -Metal Windows, Pots & Pans
- -Anything that is metal

Compost:

This pile is for items such as grass, leaves, flowers, plants and Christmas Trees

Brush:

This pile is for yard waste, which consists of: Branches, trees (no logs, must be separate from brush)

Other Acceptable Items:

- -Batteries
- -Flectronics
- -Used cooking oil
- -Used antifreeze
