Workers' Compensation Requirements Under Workers' Compensation Law §57

Please note that ACCORD forms are NOT acceptable proof of New York State Workers' Compensation. Under Workers' Compensation Law (WCL) Section 57, businesses requesting permits, licenses, or seeking to enter into contracts MUST provide ONE of the following forms to the entity issuing the permit or entering into a contract effective December 1, 2008:

CE-200 Certificate of Attestation of Exemption from New York State Workers' Compensation and/or Disability Benefits Insurance Coverage (December 1, 2008) which replaces the WC/DB-100 (9-07) form, available at : <u>http://www.wcb.ny.gov/content/main/forms/Forms_EMPLOYER.jsp</u> OR

C-105 Certificate of Workers' Compensation Insurance; OR

U-26.3 State Insurance Fund's version of the C-105.2 form OR

SI-12 Certificate of Workers' Compensation Self-Insurance (the business call the Board's Self-Insurance Office at 518-402-0247).

Two types of entities may apply for a certificate to show they are exempt from the requirement to provide workers' compensation and/or disability and Paid Family Leave benefits coverage:

- 1. New York entities with no employees
- 2. Out-of-state entities obtaining a contract or license where all the work is performed outside of New York State

Only these two types of entities may apply for a *Certificate of Attestation of Exemption (CE-200)*. This certificate can only be used to attest **to a government entity** that an applicant requesting a permit, license, or contract is not required to carry workers' compensation and/or disability and Paid Family Leave benefits coverage.

- Certificates are only valid for the specific license, permit or contract. Certificates for building permits are job-specific and a separate certificate will be required for each building permit.
- Certificates are assigned a unique certificate number that can be validated by the government official issuing the license, permit, or contract.

Disability Benefits requirements under Workers' Compensation Law §220(8)

Under Workers' Compensation Law (WCL) Section 57, businesses requesting permits, licenses, or seeking to enter into contracts MUST provide ONE of the following forms to the entity issuing the permit or entering into a contract:

DB-120.1 Certificate of Disability Benefits Insurance (the business's insurance carrier will send this form upon request; OR

DB-155 Certificate of Disability Benefits Self-Insurance (the business calls the Board's Self-Insurance Office at 518-402-0247

Please note that for building permits ONLY, certain homeowners of 1, 2,3, or 4 family owner-occupied residences serving as their own General Contractor may be eligible to file the **CE-200 Certificate of Attestation of Exemption from New York State Workers' Compensation and/or Disability Benefits Insurance Coverage** form available at:
