Discussion

Timber Operations are heavily regulated by New York State through the NYSDEC. New York State would like to regulate it similarly to an Agricultural Use. Ag & Markets requires that the timber harvested and processes be from the farmers land or land that is rented by the farmer, and that the gross proceeds are less that from other crops produced on the property. In 2019 there is a new initiative with the state that would require the town to submit proposed legislation for approval by the NYSDEC. IF the NYSDEC disapproves the legislation, then the town could still adopt the legislation with a majority plus one. The town could choose to regulate timber operations similarly to Agriculture in terms of setbacks. Do we need to regulate timber operation as they are heavily regulated by the state. Scott will contact the town attorney regarding the status of the Coon Hill timber operation.
